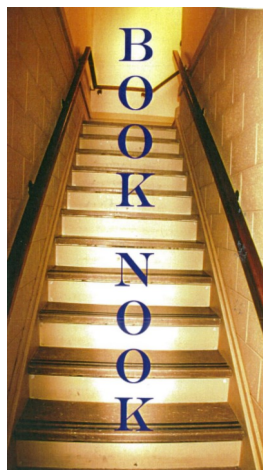
We're not just books—The **West Branch District Library** carries a massive selection of classic and new movie releases, along with full seasons of your favorite shows.

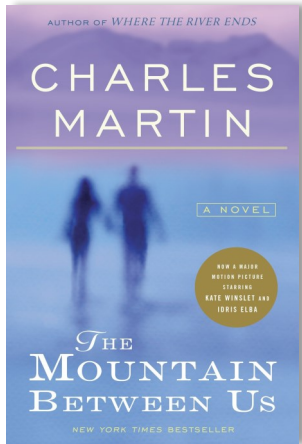

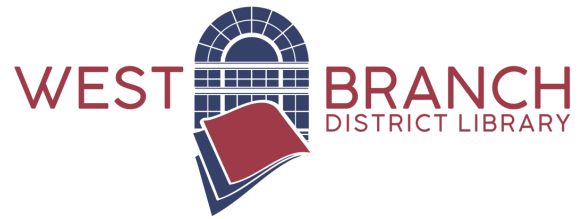

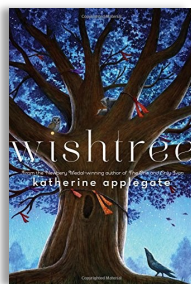
