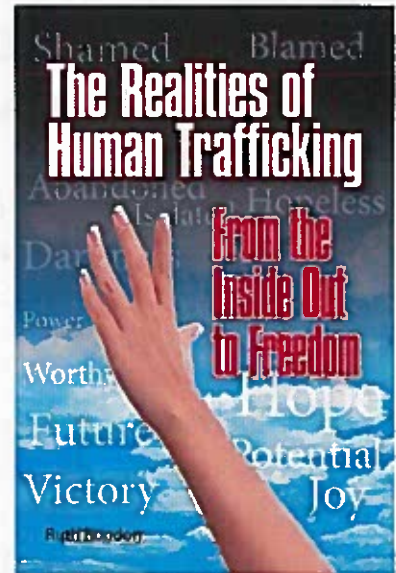


Books for Lunch

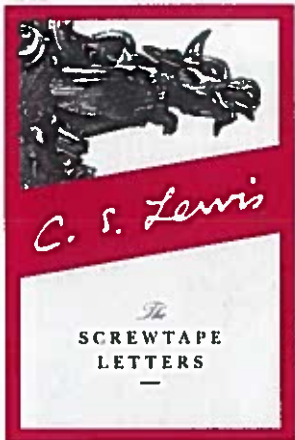

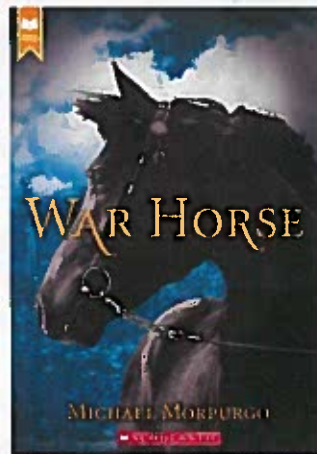
